Please review the following list of aspirin containing products and other herbs and supplements that must be stopped 2 weeks before your surgery. Please note this is only a partial list, and some other medicines may apply. Please contact the office if you have any questions.

If you are on oral contraceptives or hormone replacement therapy - please discuss if you should discontinue use prior to surgery with your primary care physician.

Aspirin Containing Products — You may take Tylenol for pain or headache.
